Accomplishments: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Eased neighborhood traffic congestion by implementing a Neighborhood Traffic Management Program, a process in which residents have input into solving traffic problems.▪ Built \$15M 2-story underground parking structure at Metlox site with 460 new public parking spaces to help relieve parking situation downtown.▪ Addressed issues at Sand Dune Park; installed a parking circle, and moved parked cars away from neighboring properties.	Vision: <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ To reduce cut-through traffic affecting quality of life for residents near their homes.▪ To utilize the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program to enable residents to solve traffic issues.▪ Jim also continues to find solutions for parking problems near Mira Costa High School.
